

2022 MICHIGAN COMPETITION

The May competition at Michigan International Speedway yielded fantastic results for the team, as we placed 7th overall out of 99 total teams.

The 7th overall placing is comprised of a 13th place result in Endurance and Acceleration, 7th in Autocross, 20th in Fuel Efficiency, 2nd place in Skidpad, 27th in Design, 36th in Business Presentation, and a cost score of 42nd.
